



SBP will close for Patriotic Holidays

The Superintendency of Banks of Panama (SBP) will be closed to the public on November 3, 4, 5 and 10, 2009, in light of the Patriotic Holidays. November 6 will be a regular work day.

Pursuant to S.B.P. Resolution No. 124-2006 of December 4, 2006, the option to close on national holidays or mourning days will be left at the discretion of the Banks.

Thus, each Bank must take the necessary measures to disclose the adopted schedule to their customers. Among said measures, a visible sign must be placed in the Bank and all its premises and it must notify the Superintendency of Banks.

Likewise, it must maintain the adequate safety in the banking premises that provides peace of mind to users and its employees when executing their transactions and operations, and apply the norms the Labor Code stipulates for that effect.
