



### **Training Seminar for BCT International Bank, S.A.**

As part of the program to keep the banks that form the International Banking Center up-to-date, the Superintendency of Banks of Panama (SBP) carried out a training session to officers of BCT International Bank, S.A.

The training aimed to reinforce and broaden the knowledge of the collaborators of this banking institution regarding the application of the Discount Rate on Farming and Stockbreeding Loans, since BCT Bank ventures in this type of portfolio.

Carlos Conte, Faryde Melgar and Romelis Gonzalez of FECl, together with Carmen Gormaz of the Legal Directorate, were in charge of informing the representatives of the bank on the Legal Framework of Law 4 of May 1994 and Executive Decree No. 29 of August 1996. Similarly, they instructed the audience on the forms to be submitted to the SBP, the FECl Claims Attention Process and the Application Analysis of the Discount Rate Applied on Loans granted by BCT International Bank, S.A.

In its role as the regulatory entity, the SBP develops continuous training programs, with the purpose of updating and instructing the operational and technical staff of the Banks of the marketplace
