



## **SBP goes to the XII Annual Meeting of the Association of Supervisors of Banks of the Americas**

The Superintendent of Banks of Panama, Alberto Diamond, attended the XII Annual Meeting of the Association of Supervisors of Banks of the Americas (ASBA), which took place on November 11 to 14 in the city of Lima, Peru.

The meeting gathered renowned professionals of the banking and financial sector to define the priorities in banking regulation and supervision, discuss the design of a more consistent supervision and regulation framework for the financial sector, and listen to the voices of the region regarding the challenges that the financial sector will face in the near future.

The background theme was "towards a new financial market"; plus interesting expositions on banking regulation and supervision after the crisis, macroprudential regulation and regional priorities in matters of banking regulation and supervision.

ASBA is an association that seeks to develop, disseminate and promote banking supervision practices in the Americas in line with international standards. Similarly, it supports the development of capabilities and resources in banking supervision in the Americas through the effective provision of technical cooperation training and services.

At this time, ASBA is composed by the highest banking oversight and regulation organizations in 35 countries of the American Continent, and it maintains ties with diverse international fora such as Basel Committee for Banking Supervision as well as diverse regional supervisor groups.
