Article 17 of Executive Decree 29 dated 8 August 1996 establishes that Banks and Finance Entities must submit the amounts collected for the 1% withholding of the previous month, the information on the loans granted to qualified sectors, the discount applied to the interest and the total or partial amount of compensation or reimbursement to which they are entitled, as well as any other additional information that the Superintendency may request for the correct application of Law 4 of May 1994 and its regulations to the Superintendency of Banks within the first ten (10) days of each month.

The first ten (10) business days are used in calculating the established reporting period.
