Dear General Manager:

We wish to inform you hereby that the Board of Directors of the Superintendency of Banks has issued Board of Directors' General Resolution SBP-GJD-0001-2020 dated 11 February 2020 "Whereby special considerations are provided for the expired passports of Venezuelan nationals with reference to the information requirement of Article 14 of Rule 10-2015," in accordance with the provisions of Executive Decree 1316 dated 10 December 2019.

By means of this Resolution, a special consideration is established for the information requirement referred to in item 1 of Article 14 of Rule 10-2015, to recognize the expired passports of Venezuelans that are located in our national territory as valid and current within the due diligence process. This temporary recognition will be applicable to passports expired on or after December 12, 2016 for two (2) years from the promulgation of Executive Decree 1316 dated 10 December 2019, i.e. until December 12, 2021.
