Circular on the Updating of Table SB109 (CINU)

Breakdown of changes made in the new version

Also includes the cultivation of sweet potatoes, cocoyam, yams, cassava, taro, and other roots and tubers.</p> <p>Excludes onions (account A.01.011.0113.01132) and potatoes (account A.01.011.0113.01131)</p>
A.01.011.0119.01193	Other non-perennial produce	<p>This classification encompasses the cultivation of all other non-perennial crops such as fodder beet or kohlrabi, forage, clover, alfalfa, sainfoin, corn, and other grasses for forage, kale, and similar forage products. Also covers the cultivation of beet seeds (excluding sugar beet), forage seeds and plants, and flower cultivation including flower cutting and flower bud production, and cultivation of flower seeds.</p> <p>Excludes the cultivation of sugar beets (see 0113) and non-perennial spices, aromatic, medicinal, and pharmaceutical crops (see 0128).</p>
A.01.012.0127.01273	Other beverage crops	<p>This classification encompasses the cultivation of beverage products such as tea, mate, cocoa, and other beverage crops.</p> <p>Excludes coffee (account A.01.012.01127.01271).</p>

The new section titled “OTHER CLASSIFICATIONS” added to Table SB109 is not an original part of the National Standard Industrial Classification activities (CINU). However, the inclusion of this new section aims to report **deposits** from individuals whose income does is not derived from economic activities (see No. 11 of the Annex of this circular), and it should not be utilized to report loans in the “Economic Activities” field.
