Ref.: Pilot Plan Information Meeting

Dear General Manager:

For several months, the Superintendency of Banks has dedicated efforts to developing a Pilot Plan aimed at identifying improvements to streamline account opening process and enhance the updating of customer data and records, without compromising the progress made in complying with international antimoney laundering standards – compliance that was instrumental in removing Panama from the FATF gray list.

This Pilot Plan was developed with the participation of several banking institutions, resulting in a set of conclusions and recommendations. We wish to share these outcomes with all banks in the system, so they may consider the findings for analysis and evaluation, as these may affect their current processes and procedures. Additionally, the implementation of these findings will result in changes to this Superintendency supervisory approach.

Accordingly, we are pleased to extend a formal invitation to you and the Vice Presidents responsible for Compliance, Business, and Customer Data Updating to attend this important informative session, which is key to the continued development of the banking sector.
