

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

THE ACTING SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS

INFORMS:

A break in a 30-inch pipe located on Vía Brasil in Panama City has affected the normal flow of water in the areas surrounding Plaza Canaima, where the offices of the Superintendency of Banks are located, causing the interruption of the drinking water supply and the operation of the building's central air conditioning system.

The National Institute of Aqueducts and Sewers (IDAAN, for its acronym in Spanish) has advised that system recovery could take between 8 and 12 hours from the time potable water flow is reestablished. Therefore, it is necessary to suspend the regular course of business as of 2:00 p.m. today.

Consequently, the procedural and administrative deadlines will be extended due to this closure, i.e. until ten o'clock (10:00 a.m.) on Monday, February 26, 2018, as provided for in Resolution SBP-ADM-0006-2018 dated 23 February 2018.
