That pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph 6 of Article 17 of Decree Law 9 dated 26 February 1998, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for this request;

That the above transfer of shares from HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ), S.A. owned by GRUPO FINANCIERO HSBC S.A. DE C.V. to HSBC ASIA HOLDINGS B.V. raises no objections and should be approved;

RESOLVES:

To acquiesce to and approve the transfer of total shares of HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ), S.A. owned by GRUPO FINANCIERO HSBC S.A. DE C.V. to HSBC ASIA HOLDINGS B.V.
