That pursuant to the provisions of Article 40 of Decree Law 9 of 1998, **HSBC BANK** (**PANAMÁ**), **S.A.** has submitted a request for authorization to close its branch office located in suites 15 and 16 of the Hospital complex at Punta Pacifica, township of San Francisco and move it to a new location in suites L12A, L12B and L3 on the first floor of "B" Tower of PH Torre de las Americas at Calle Punta Darien and Calle Punta Coronado in Punta Pacifica, township of San Francisco, district of Panama as of 7 June 2008;
