CONSIDERING:

That by means of Resolution S.B.P. 161-2007 dated 18 October 2007, CITIBANK, N.A. Panama Branch was authorized to share the managerial and technical support staff of its back and middle offices with BANCO UNO, S.A. and BANCO CUSCATLÁN DE PANAMÁ, S.A. until 30 June 2008, under the conditions set forth in the request submitted for authorization;

That **CITIBANK**, **N.A. Panama Branch** has requested authorization to share the staff referred to in Resolution S.B.P. 161-2007 dated 18 October 2007, until 30 December 2008;

That **CITIBANK**, **N.A. Panama Branch** submitted the request because of the new schedule for migrating the computer systems of the banks as part of their integration process; and

That after the relevant analysis, the request submitted by CITIBANK, N.A. Panama Branch raises no objections.

RESOLVES:

To authorize **CITIBANK**, **N.A. Panama Branch** an extension until 30 December 2008 for sharing the staff referred to in Resolution S.B.P. 161-2007 dated 18 October 2008 with **BANCO UNO**, **S.A.** and **BANCO CUSCATLÁN DE PANAMÁ**, **S.A.**

PROVISO: The authorization is not applicable to the duties of the Compliance officers of **CITIBANK**, **N.A.**, **BANCO UNO**, **S.A.** and **BANCO CUSCATLÁN DE PANAMÁ**, **S.A.**, which must be conducted separately and independently by the persons appointed in each of the banks pursuant to the provisions of Rule 10-2000.
