CONSIDERING:

That **BANCO BOLIVARIANO**, **C.A.**, a corporation established and existing according to the laws of Ecuador, acting as promoter, has submitted an application through its Resident Agents for a Temporary Permit for **BANCO BOLIVARIANO** (**PANAMÁ**), **S.A.** – under organization – to notarize and file the documents related to its incorporation in the Public Registry, to subsequently apply for a General License;

That based on the criteria for Temporary Permit applications, the application submitted by **BANCO BOLIVARIANO**, **C.A.** raises no objections; and

That pursuant to Article 16 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for the application submitted by **BANCO BOLIVARIANO**, **C.A.**

RESOLVES:

To grant **BANCO BOLIVARIANO** (**PANAMÁ**), **S.A.** – under organization – a ninety-(90) day Temporary Permit to notarize and file the documents related to its incorporation in the Public Registry, to subsequently apply for a General License.
