RESOLUTION S.B.P. 485-2008

(dated 31 December 2008)

The Superintendent of Banks, in use of his legal powers, and

CONSIDERING:

That **CITIBANK**, **N.A.** is a bank holding a General Banking License granted by the Superintendency to engage in the banking business in and from the Republic of Panama;

That **BANCO CITIBANK** (**PANAMÁ**), **S.A.** is a bank holding a General Banking License granted by the Superintendency to engage in the banking business in and from the Republic of Panama;

That CITIBANK, N.A. and BANCO CITIBANK (PANAMÁ), S.A., companies that belong to the same Economic Group, have submitted a request to the Superintendency for authorization to use the name CITI as the commercial name of both entities;

That Rule 1-81 of the National Banking Commission, today known as the Superintendency of Banks, governs the use of commercial names to identify banks;

That there is no objection from the Superintendency to the submitted request, deeming it appropriate to use the new commercial name requested.

RESOLVES:

<u>FIRST</u>: To authorize CITIBANK, N.A. and BANCO CITIBANK (PANAMÁ), S.A. to use CITI as their commercial name.

<u>SECOND</u>: CITIBANK, N.A. and BANCO CITIBANK (PANAMÁ), N.A. must place their corporate name alongside the commercial name CITI when either of them uses it, as required by Article 1 of Rule 1-81 above.
