**RESOLUTION S.B.P. 131-2009**  
(dated 2 June 2009)

The Superintendent of Banks,  
in use of his legal powers, and

**CONSIDERING:**

That by means of Resolution S.B.P. 52-2007 dated 2 May 2007, the Superintendency of Banks granted **NATIXIS** an International License that authorized it to engage in the banking business from the Republic of Panama;

That by means of Resolution S.B.P. 347-2008 dated 5 December 2008 the Superintendency authorized **NATIXIS** to start a Voluntary Liquidation process;

That the Superintendency has verified the conclusion of the Liquidation process pursuant to the Liquidation Plan submitted;

That pursuant to Article 122 of the Banking Law, and after the conclusion of the Liquidation Process;

**RESOLVES:**

To rescind Resolution S.B.P. 52-2007 dated 2 may 2007 whereby **NATIXIS** was granted an International License to engage in the banking business from the Republic of Panama and to cancel that License.

Once this Resolution is reported, a copy of it must be submitted to the Directorate General of the Public Registry and published in a newspaper with broad national circulation for three consecutive business days.
