That **BANCO FINANCIA**, **S.A.** (**BMF**) is a corporation established according to the laws of the Republic of Panama, filed under Micro jacket 589997, Document 1236235 in the Microfilm (Mercantile) Section of the Public Registry and the holder of a General Banking License granted by means of Resolution S.B.P. 12-2008 dated 16 January 2008;

That, through its Resident Agent, **BANCO FINANCIA**, **S.A.** (**BMF**) requested authorization to change its Corporate Name to **BANCO G & T CONTINENTAL** (**PANAMÁ**), **S.A.** (**BMF**);

That pursuant to the provisions of Rule 1-87 dated 17 February 1981, only one name can be authorized for use as a Bank's Corporate Name;
