The Superintendent of Banks in use of his legal powers, and

## CONSIDERING:

That BANCO CITIBANK (PANAMÁ), S.A. is a corporation established and existing according to the laws of the Republic of Panama, duly filed under Micro jacket 425041, Document 404934 in the Microfilm (Mercantile) Section of the Public Registry of Panama and the holder of a General Banking License granted by the Superintendency by means of Resolution 101 dated 10 December 2002;

That pursuant to Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, BANCO CITIBANK (PANAMÁ), S.A. has informed the Superintendency that it will close its branch office in Plaza Carolina, located in suite 2 of Centro Comercial Plaza Carolina on Avenida Jose Agustin Arango, as of 20 November 2009;

That after notifying its customers, BANCO CITIBANK (PANAMÁ), S.A. will provide services to the customers of the closed branch from any of its banking establishments;

That pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph I, Subparagraph 2 of Article 16 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for closing banking establishments; and

That after the relevant analysis, the request submitted by BANCO CITIBANK (PANAMÁ), S.A. raises no objections;

## RESOLVES:

To authorize BANCO CITIBANK (PANAMÁ), S.A. to close its branch office in Plaza Carolina, located in suite 2 of Centro Comercial Plaza Carolina on Avenida Jose Agustin Arango, as of 20 November 2009.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Paragraph 2, Article 58; and Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I, Article 16 of the Banking Law.
