**RESOLUTION S.B.P. 250-2009**  
(dated 12 November 2009)

The Interim Superintendent of Banks  
in use of his legal powers, and

**CONSIDERING:**

That **BANCO G & T CONTINENTAL (PANAMÁ), S.A. (BMF)** is a corporation established according to the laws of the Republic of Panama, filed under Micro jacket 589997, Document 12362335 in the Microfilm (Mercantile) Section of the Public Registry and the holder of a General Banking License granted by means of Resolution S.B.P. 12-2008 dated 16 January 2008;

That **BANCO G & T CONTINENTAL (PANAMÁ), S.A. (BMF)** has submitted a request to the Superintendency for authorization to use the name “**BANCO G & T CONTINENTAL (BMF)**” as its trade name;

That Rule 1-87 of the National Banking Commission, today known as the Superintendency of Banks, regulates the use of trade names to identify banks;

That there is no objection to the request from the Superintendency and the use of the new trade name should be authorized.

**RESOLVES:**

**FIRST:** To authorize **BANCO G & T CONTINENTAL (PANAMÁ), S.A. (BMF)** to use the name “**BANCO G & T CONTINENTAL (BMF)**” as its trade name.

**SECOND:** **BANCO G & T CONTINENTAL (PANAMÁ), S.A. (BMF)** must ensure it always puts its corporate name alongside the trade name **BANCO G & T CONTINENTAL (BMF)**, as provided for in Article 1 of Rule 1-81.
