That through its Resident Agents, **BANQUE SAFDIÉ**, **S.A.**, a bank established according to the laws of Switzerland, has submitted a Temporary Permit application to formalize and file the documents related to its incorporation and registration in the Public Registry in Panama, to subsequently apply for a Representation License that will allow it to establish a Representative Office in Panama;

That under the analysis criteria prescribed for Temporary Permit applications, the application submitted by **BANQUE SAFDIÉ**, **S.A.** raises no objections; and

That pursuant to the provisions of Article 16 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for the application submitted by **BANQUE SAFDIÉ**, **S.A.**

RESOLVES:

To authorize a ninety- (90) day Temporary Permit to **BANQUE SAFDIÉ**, **S.A.**to formalize and file the documents related to its incorporation and registration as a foreign corporation in the Public Registry, to subsequently apply for a Representation License.
