RESOLUTION S.B.P. 056-2009

(dated 26 February 2009)

The Superintendent of Banks in use of his legal powers, and

CONSIDERING:

That **HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ), S.A.** is a corporation filed under Micro jacket 456744, Document 633197 of the Public Registry and the holder of a General License granted by the Superintendency by means of Resolution S.B.P. 187-2004 dated 2 July 2004;

That through its resident agents, **HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ)**, **S.A.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to open a Representative Office in Managua, Republic of Nicaragua;

That, pursuant to the provisions of Article 58 of the Banking Law and Rule 4-2002 dated 3 April 2002, opening establishments abroad must have the previous approval of the Superintendency;

That besides requesting the Superintendency's authorization to open a Representative Office in Managua, Republic of Nicaragua, **HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ), S.A.** must request authorization from the Superintendency of Banks and Other Financial Institutions of Nicaragua, the entity responsible for financial supervision in that country;

That after the relevant analysis, the request submitted by **HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ)**, **S.A.** raises no objections;

That pursuant to the provisions of Article 16 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for these requests.

RESOLVES:

- **ARTICLE 1**: To authorize **HSBC BANK** (**PANAMÁ**), **S.A.** to open a Representative Office in Managua, Republic of Nicaragua.
- <u>ARTICLE 2</u>: The authorization hereby granted does not exempt HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ), S.A. from complying with the relevant Nicaraguan legal and regulatory requirements.

Legal Grounds: Banking Law and Rule 4-2002 dated 3 April 2002.
