WHEREAS:

By means of Resolution No. 12-78 of 18 July 1978 issued by the National Banking Commission, Banco Latinoamericano de Comercio Exterior, S.A. (BLADEX) (previously known as Banco Latinoamericano de Exportaciones, S.A.) (BLADEX), a bank duly organized according to the laws of the Republic of Panama, was granted with a General Banking License to engage in the banking business in or from the Republic of Panama;
