That in its application, **BANCO CITIBANK (PANAMÁ), S.A.** announces that it has identified new trust business opportunities that could be carried out under the Bank's Trust License:

That the Bank still meets the requirements established in legislation for maintaining a valid Trust License, and it has the appropriate personnel and infrastructure to keep providing trust services in Panama;

Pursuant to Law 1 of 5 January 1984 and Executive Decree 16 of 3 October 1984, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for this type of application;

RESOLVES:

<u>SOLE ARTICLE</u>: To accept the withdrawal of the application to irrevocably cancel the Trust License previously granted toBANCO CITIBANK (PANAMÁ), S.A.

<u>Legal Grounds</u>: Law 1 of 5 January 1984 and Executive Decree 16 of 3 October 1984, Law 38 of 2000
