S.B.P. RESOLUTION No. 0047-2012 (dated 9 May 2012)

The Superintendent of Banks, in use of his legal powers, and

CONSIDERING:

That **Multibank**, **Inc.** is a bank organized pursuant to Panamanian Law, holds a General Banking License granted by Resolution 38-87 dated 4 December 1987;

That **Multibank**, **Inc.** has requested authorization to establish a bank subsidiary (wholly owned by Multibank, Inc.) in the Cayman Islands under a type "B" Banking License;

That pursuant to the provisions of Article 58 of the Banking Law and Rule 4-2002 dated 3 April 2002, opening banking establishments abroad requires the prior approval of the Superintendency;

That, besides requesting prior authorization from the Superintendency, **MULTIBANK**, **INC.** must proceed according to existing legislation in the Cayman Islands, where it will be established;

That after the relevant analysis, the application submitted by **MULTIBANK**, **INC.** raises no objections;

That, pursuant to the provisions in Article 16, Ordinal I, Paragraph 2 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for this request.

RESOLVES:

<u>ARTICLE 1</u>: To authorize **MULTIBANK**, **INC**. to establish a bank subsidiary (wholly owned by **MULTIBANK**, **INC**.) in the Cayman Islands, under a type "B" Banking License.

<u>ARTICLE 2</u>: The authorization hereby granted is without prejudice to compliance with the current legal and regulatory standards of the Cayman Islands, with which **MULTIBANK, INC.** must comply.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Banking Law and Rule 4-2002 dated 3 April 2002.
