CONSIDERING:

That **BANCOLOMBIA**, **S.A.**, a bank organized according to the laws of Colombia, has requested a TEMPORARY PERMIT to formalize and file the documents related to its organization and registration in Panama in the Public Registry, for the purpose of subsequently applying for a General Banking License as a Bank Branch;

That under the analysis criteria for TEMPORARY PERMIT applications, the application submitted by **BANCOLOMBIA**, **S.A.** raises no objections, and

That pursuant to Paragraph 1 of Article 16 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent is the approving authority for the application submitted by **BANCOLOMBIA**, **S.A.**

RESOLVES:

To grant **BANCOLOMBIA**, **S.A.** a ninety (90) day TEMPORARY PERMIT to formalize and file the documents related to its organization and registration in Panama in the Public Registry, for the purpose of subsequently applying for a General Banking License.
