RESOLUTION SBP No. 0061-2014 (dated 21 May 2014)

THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS,

in use of his legal powers, and

CONSIDERING:

That by means of Resolution 12-78 dated 18 July 1978 of the National Banking Commission, **BANCO LATINOAMERICANO DE COMERCIO EXTERIOR, S.A.** (formerly known as Banco Latinoamericano de Exportaciones, S.A.) (BLADEX), a bank established according to the laws of the Republic of Panama, was granted a General License that authorizes the bank to engage in the banking business both in and from the Republic of Panama;

That **BANCO LATINOAMERICANO DE COMERCIO EXTERIOR, S.A. (BLADEX)** has requested authorization to open one (1) subsidiary in the United States of Mexico and one (1) subsidiary in Panama;

That according to the provisions of Article 58 of the Banking Law and Rule 4-2002 dated 3 April 2002, opening establishments abroad must have the prior approval of the Superintendency;

That besides requesting Superintendency's authorization to open subsidiaries in the United States of Mexico and Panama, BANCO LATINOAMERICANO DE COMERCIO EXTERIOR, S.A. (BLADEX) must comply with current legislation in the country where the subsidiaries will be located;

That after the relevant analysis, the application submitted by **BANCO LATINOAMERICANO DE COMERCIO EXTERIOR, S.A. (BLADEX)** raises no objections;

That, pursuant to the provisions in Article 16 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for this request;

RESOLVES:

FIRST: To authorize **BANCO LATINOAMERICANO DE COMERCIO EXTERIOR, S.A.** (**BLADEX**) to establish two (2) subsidiaries, one (1) in the United States of Mexico and one (1) in Panama.

<u>SECOND</u>: The authorization hereby granted does not exempt **BANCO LATINOAMERICANO DE COMERCIO EXTERIOR**, **S.A.** (**BLADEX**) from compliance with the current legal and regulatory requirements in Mexico and Panama, with which it must comply.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Banking Law and Rule 4-2002 dated 3 April 2002.
