That by means of Resolution 2-83 dated 7 January 1983, **BANCO BILBAO VIZCAYA ARGENTARIA (PANAMÁ)**, **S.A.**, today known as **BANCO BAC DE PANAMÁ**, **S.A.**, was granted a General License that authorized it to engage in the Banking Business in and from the Republic of Panama under a General Banking License granted by the National Banking Commission, today known as the Superintendency of Banks;

That by means of Resolution SBP-158-2014 dated 3 December 2014, **BAC INTERNATIONAL BANK, INC.** was authorized to assume all assets, property, rights, privileges, powers and franchises, as well as all liabilities and obligations, of **BANCO BAC DE PANAMÁ, S.A.** by means of a Merger Agreement dated 28 October 2014 under which the latter bank would be dissolved as a legal entity;

That pursuant to Article 22 of Rule 1-2004 dated 29 December 2004, the completion of the merger process between **BAC INTERNATIONAL BANK, INC.** and **BANCO BAC DE PANAMÁ, S.A.** was reported, and

That the Superintendency has verified the completion of the merger process between **BAC INTERNATIONAL BANK, INC.** and **BANCO BAC DE PANAMÁ, S.A.** pursuant to Rule 1-2004 dated 29 December 2004.

RESOLVES:

To rescind Resolution 2-83 dated 7 January 1983 whereby **BANCO BILBAO VIZCAYA ARGENTARIA (PANAMÁ), S.A.**, today known as **BANCO BAC DE PANAMÁ, S.A.**, was granted a General License to engage in the Banking Business in and from the Republic of Panama and to cancel that License.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Banking Law and Rule 1-2004 dated 29 December 2004.
