## Republic of Panama Superintendency of Banks

**RESOLUTION SBP-0190-2017**  
(dated 17 October 2017)

**THE ACTING SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS**  
in use of his legal powers, and

### WHEREAS:

**BANCO AZTECA (PANAMÁ), S.A.** is a bank authorized to engage in the Banking Business in and from the Republic of Panama under a General Banking License granted by the Superintendency of Banks by means of Resolution SB 224-2004 dated 24 November 2004;

Pursuant to Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, **BANCO AZTECA (PANAMÁ), S.A.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to permanently close its branch office located in La Gran Estación, district of San Miguelito, province of Panama, as of 30 October 2017;

According to Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I of Article 16 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for closing banking establishments, and

After the relevant analyses, the request submitted by **BANCO AZTECA (PANAMÁ), S.A.** raises no objections.

### RESOLVES:

To authorize **BANCO AZTECA (PANAMÁ), S.A.** to permanently close its branch office located in La Gran Estación, district of San Miguelito, province of Panama.

**LEGAL GROUNDS:** Paragraph 2, Article 58 and Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I, Article 16 of the Banking Law.
