WHEREAS:

BANCO CREDIT ANDORRA (PANAMÁ), S.A. is a bank authorized to engage in the banking business in and from the Republic of Panama under a General License granted by means of Resolution SBP 207-2008 dated 28 August 2008;

By means of Resolution SBP 282-2010 dated 24 December 2010, the Superintendency authorized **BANCO CREDIT ANDORRA (PANAMÁ), S.A.** to open a Representative Office in Uruguay;

Pursuant to Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, **BANCO CREDIT ANDORRA** (**PANAMÁ**), **S.A.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to close its Representative Office located in the Oriental Republic of Uruguay;

Pursuant to Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I of Article 16 and Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent is the approving authority for closing banking establishments, and:

After the relevant analyses, the request submitted by **BANCO CREDIT ANDORRA** (**PANAMÁ**), **S.A.** raises no objections.

RESOLVES:

To authorize **BANCO CREDIT ANDORRA (PANAMÁ), S.A.** to close its Representative Office located in the Oriental Republic of Uruguay.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Paragraph I of Article 16 and Article 58 of the Banking Law; Resolution SBP 156-2013 dated 30 September 2013 and Resolution SBP-0167-2013 dated 25 October 2013
