**THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS**  
in use of his legal powers, and

**WHEREAS:**

**BANCO SANTANDER (PANAMÁ), S.A.** is a bank established and existing according to Panamanian Law and authorized to engage in the banking business from the Republic of Panama under an International Banking License granted by the Superintendency, by means of Resolution 132-2003 dated 3 September 2003;

**BANCO SANTANDER (PANAMÁ), S.A.**, which is under the Voluntary Liquidation of its operations, requested authorization to move its offices currently located on the 15<sup>th</sup> floor of SFC Tower, Calle 55, Obarrio to its new location in suites 1719 and 1720 on the 17<sup>th</sup> floor, PH Financial Park, Boulevard Costa del Este, Costa del Este, Township of Parque Lefevre, city of Panama;

After the relevant analyses, the request submitted by **BANCO SANTANDER (PANAMÁ), S.A.** raises no objections; and

According to Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I of Article 16 and Article 58 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for moving banking establishments,

**RESOLVES:**

To authorize **BANCO SANTANDER (PANAMÁ), S.A.** to move its offices currently located on the 15<sup>th</sup> floor of SFC Tower, Calle 55, Obarrio to its new location in suites 1719 and 1720 on the 17<sup>th</sup> floor, PH Financial Park, Boulevard Costa del Este, Costa del Este, Township of Parque Lefevre, city of Panama.

**LEGAL GROUNDS:** Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I, Article 16 and Paragraph 2, Article 58 of the Banking Law.
