RESOLUTION SBP-0130-2018
(dated 24 September 2018)

THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS
in use of his legal powers, and

WHEREAS:

CREDICORP BANK, S.A. is a corporation established and existing according to the laws of the Republic of Panama and authorized to engage in the banking business in and from the Republic of Panama under a General Banking License granted by the National Banking Commission, today known Superintendency of Banks, by means of Resolution SBP 1-93 dated 13 January 1983;

Pursuant to Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, **CREDICORP BANK, S.A.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to close its branch office located on Avenida Peru and Calle 37, as of 1 October 2018;

According to Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I of Article 16 and Article 58 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for closing banking establishments, and

After the relevant analyses, the request submitted by **CREDICORP BANK, S.A.** raises no objections.

RESOLVES:

To authorize **CREDICORP BANK, S.A.** to close its branch office located on Avenida Peru and Calle 37.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Paragraph 2, Article 58 and Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I, Article 16 of the Banking Law.
