RESOLUTION SBP-0020-2019
(dated 19 February 2019)

THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS
in use of his legal powers, and

WHEREAS:

CREDICORP BANK, S.A. is a bank established and existing according to the Laws of the Republic of Panama and authorized to engage in the banking business in and from the Republic of Panama under a General Banking License granted by the National Banking Commission, today known as the Superintendency of Banks, by means of Resolution 1-93 dated 13 January 1993;

Pursuant to Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, **CREDICORP BANK, S.A.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to close the Multiplaza branch office located in the township of San Francisco, district of Panama, as of 1 March 2019;

CREDICORP BANK, S.A. has planned to move its customer operations primarily to the Torre de las Américas branch office, located in the township of San Francisco, district of Panama;

According to Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I of Article 16 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for closing banking establishments, and

After the relevant analyses, the request submitted by **CREDICORP BANK, S.A.** raises no objections.

RESOLVES:

To authorize **CREDICORP BANK, S.A.** to close its Multiplaza branch office as of 1 March 2019.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Paragraph 2, Article 58 and Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I, Article 16 of the Banking Law.
