# Republic of Panama Superintendency of Banks

### **RESOLUTION SBP-0081-2019**

(dated 17 May 2019)

### THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS

in use of his legal powers, and

#### WHEREAS:

**MULTIBANK, INC.** is a corporation established according to the Laws of the Republic of Panama, authorized to engage in the banking business under a General Banking License granted, at that time, by means of Resolution 38-87 dated 4 December 1987 by the National Banking Commission, today known as Superintendency of Banks;

By means of Resolution SBP-0143-2015 dated 15 September 2015, the Superintendency authorized **MULTIBANK**, **INC.** to open a Representative Office in the Republic of Cuba;

Pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, **MULTIBANK, INC.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to close its Representative Office currently located in the Republic of Cuba;

Pursuant to the provisions of Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I of Article 16 and Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is responsible for authorizing the closing of banking establishments; and

After the relevant analyses, the request submitted by **MULTIBANK**, **INC**. raises no objections;

# **RESOLVES:**

To authorize the closing of the Representative Office that **MULTIBANK**, **INC.** currently has in the Republic of Cuba.

**LEGAL GROUNDS**: Paragraph 2, Article 58 and Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I, Article 16 of the Banking Law.
