WHEREAS:

BANCO FICOHSA (PANAMÁ), S.A. is a bank established and existing according to the Laws of the Republic of Panama, authorized to engage in the banking business in and from the Republic of Panama under a General Banking License granted by the Superintendency of Banks, by means of Resolution SBP 162-2012 dated 20 December 2012;

Pursuant to Article 58 (2) of the Banking Law, **BANCO FICOHSA (PANAMÁ), S.A.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to close, as of 30 January 2021, the kiosks listed below:

- 2. Kiosk located inside Farmacias Arrocha "Centennial Mall," Vía Centenario, district and province of Panama.
- 3. Kiosk located inside Súper 99 "Puerto Escondido," province of Colón.

According to the provisions of Article 16 (I)(2) of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for closing banking establishments; and

After the relevant analysis, the request submitted by BANCO FICOHSA (PANAMÁ), S.A. raises no objections;

RESOLVES:

To authorize BANCO FICOHSA (PANAMÁ), S.A. to close the following establishments:

- 1. Kiosk located inside Farmacias Arrocha "Los Andes," district of San Miguelito, province of Panama.
- 2. Kiosk located inside Farmacias Arrocha "Centennial Mall," Vía Centenario, district and province of Panama.
- 3. Kiosk located inside Súper 99 "Puerto Escondido," province of Colón.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Article 58 (2) and Article 16 (I)(2) of the Banking Law.
