THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS
in use of his legal powers, and

WHEREAS:

CITIBANK, N.A. – PANAMA BRANCH is a bank authorized to engage in the Banking Business in and from the Republic of Panama under a General Banking License granted by the National Banking Commission (today known as Superintendency of Banks), by means of Resolution 54 dated 28 December 1971;

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 58 (2) of the Banking Law, **CITIBANK, N.A. – PANAMA BRANCH** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to move its branch office located in Plaza Panamá (ground floor of Credicorp Bank), Calle 50 to Torre de las Américas Bldg., 12th floor, B Tower, Panama City, as of 22 November 2021;

According to Article 16 (I)(2) of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for moving banking establishments; and

After the relevant analysis, the request submitted by **CITIBANK, N.A. – PANAMA BRANCH** raises no objections;

RESOLVES:

To authorize **CITIBANK, N.A. – PANAMA BRANCH** to move its branch office located in Plaza Panamá (ground floor of Credicorp Bank), Calle 50 to Torre de las Américas Bldg., 12th floor, B Tower, Panama City.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Article 16 (I)(2) and Article 58 (2) of the Banking Law.
