THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS
in use of his legal powers, and

WHEREAS:

METROBANK, S.A. is a bank established and existing according to the Laws of the Republic of Panama, authorized to engage in the Banking Business in and from the Republic of Panama, under a General Banking License granted, at the time, by the National Banking Commission, today known as Superintendency of Banks, by means of Resolution 7-91 dated 13 June 1991;

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 58 (2) of the Banking Law, **METROBANK, S.A.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to move its branch office located in El Dorado, Vía Ricardo J. Alfaro, Centro Comercial La Galería, to its new location in San Francisco, Calle 50, province of Panama, as of 31 December 2021;

According to Article 16 (I)(2) of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for closing banking establishments; and

After the relevant analysis, the request submitted by **METROBANK, S.A.** raises no objections.

RESOLVES:

To authorize **METROBANK, S.A.** to move its branch office located in El Dorado, Vía Ricardo J. Alfaro, Centro Comercial La Galería, to its new location in San Francisco, Calle 50, province of Panama.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Article 16 (I)(2) and Article 58 (2) of the Banking Law.
