CONSIDERING:

That **HSBC INVESTMENT CORPORATION (PANAMÁ)**, **S.A.**is a corporation duly established according to the laws of the Republic of Panama and authorized to engage in the Trust Business in and from the Republic of Panama under a Trust License granted by means of Resolution FID 3-93 dated 26 October 1993;

That **HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ), S.A.** is sole owner of the shares of **HSBC INVESTMENT CORPORATION (PANAMÁ), S.A.**;

That by means of Resolution SBP 156-2013 dated 30 September 2013, the Superintendency authorized the transfer of 100% of the shares of **HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ)**, **S.A.** and the transfer of 100% of the shares of the subsidiaries of **HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ)**, **S.A.**to **BANCOLOMBIA**, **S.A.**, pursuant to the terms established in the proposed transaction;

That by means of Resolution SBP-0167-2013 dated 25 October 2013, the Superintendency authorized **HSBC BANK (PANAMÁ), S.A.** to change its corporate name to **BANISTMO, S.A.**;

That through its resident agent, **HSBC INVESTMENT CORPORATION (PANAMÁ)**, S.A. has requested authorization to change its corporate name to **BANISTMO INVESTMENT CORPORATION**, S.A.;

That pursuant to Article 13 of Executive Decree 16 dated 3 October 1984, which regulates Law 1 dated 5 January 1984, any change to a trust company's corporate charter requires prior approval of the Superintendency; and

That the request submitted by **HSBC INVESTMENT CORPORATION (PANAMÁ), S.A. raises** no objections.

RESOLVES:

To authorize the change of corporate name from HSBC INVESTMENT CORPORATION (PANAMÁ), S.A. to BANISTMO INVESTMENT CORPORATION, S.A.
