For relevant purposes, the Superintendency wishes to inform you that in its 7198<sup>th</sup> session on 17 June 2014, the Security Council unanimously approved Resolution 2161 on measures against persons and entities associated with Al-Qaeda and the extension of the mandate of the Office of the Public Defender established by Resolution 1904 (2009).

This Resolution highlights the concern over the increase in the use of the Internet by terrorists and urges the application of the general standards contained in the Forty Revised Recommendations of the Financial Action Task Force on combatting money laundering and the financing of terrorism and their proliferation.
