RESOLUTION S.B.P. 172-2007
(dated 9 November 2007)

The Superintendent of Banks,
in use of his legal powers, and

CONSIDERING:

That **CREDIT SUISSE**, a bank established and existing according to the laws of Switzerland, has submitted an application through its Resident Agents for a Temporary Permit to notarize and file as a foreign corporation in the Public Registry, to subsequently apply for a Representation License in Panama pursuant to Decree Law 9 dated 26 February 1998;

That under the prescribed criteria for Temporary Permit applications, the application submitted by **CREDIT SUISSE** raises no objections; and

That pursuant to Paragraph 1 of Article 17 of Decree Law 9 dated 26 February 1998, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for the application submitted by **CREDIT SUISSE**.

RESOLVES:

To grant **CREDIT SUISSE** a ninety- (90) day Temporary Permit to notarize and file as a foreign corporation in the Public Registry, to subsequently apply for a Representation License.

Legal Grounds: Decree Law 9 of 1998 and Rule 3-2001 amended by Rule 2-2006.
