**THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS**  
in use of his legal powers, and

**WHEREAS:**

**CAPITAL BANK, INC.** is a bank authorized to engage in the banking business in or from the Republic of Panama under a General Banking License granted by the Superintendency of Banks by means of Resolution SBP 153-2007 dated 9 October 2007;

Pursuant to Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, **CAPITAL BANK, INC.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to move its El Dorado branch office, located in suite 1 on the ground floor and mezzanine of Centro Comercial El Dorado, to its new location on Calle 17 Norte, El Dorado, Niko's Café building, as of August 2019;

According to Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I of Article 16 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for closing or moving banking establishments, and

After the relevant analyses, the request submitted by **CAPITAL BANK, INC.** raises no objections;

**RESOLVES:**

To authorize **CAPITAL BANK, INC.** to move its El Dorado branch office, located in suite 1 on the ground floor and mezzanine of Centro Comercial El Dorado, to its new location on Calle 17 Norte, El Dorado, Niko's Café building, Panama City, province of Panama.

**LEGAL GROUNDS:** Paragraph 2, Article 58 and Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I, Article 16 of the Banking Law.
