RESOLUTION SBP-0139-2019
(dated 31 July 2019)

THE ACTING SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS
in use of his legal powers, and

WHEREAS:

CREDICORP BANK, S.A. is a bank established and existing according to the Laws of the Republic of Panama, authorized to engage in the banking business in and from the Republic of Panama by means of a General License granted by the National Banking Commission, today known as Superintendency of Banks, through Resolution 1-93 dated 13 January 1993;

Pursuant to Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, **CREDICORP BANK, S.A.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to permanently close its Panama Pacifico branch office located in suite 80 on the ground floor of PH Soleo, township of Veracruz, district of Arraijan, province of Panama Oeste, as of 30 August 2019;

According to Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I of Article 16 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for closing or moving banking establishments, and

After the relevant analyses, the request submitted by **CREDICORP BANK, S.A.** raises no objections;

By means of Resolution SBP-JD-0071-2019 dated 30 July 2019, Mr. Gustavo A. Villa was appointed Acting Superintendent from 31 July to 5 August 2019 or until the Superintendent returns to his post.

RESOLVES:

To authorize **CREDICORP BANK, S.A.** to close its Panama Pacifico branch office located in suite 80 on the ground floor of PH Soleo, township of Veracruz, district of Arraijan, province of Panama Oeste.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Subparagraph 2, Article 58 and Subparagraph 2, Paragraph I, Article 16 of the Banking Law.
