WHEREAS:

MEGA INTERNATIONAL COMMERCIAL BANK CO., LTD. is a bank authorized to engage in the banking business in and from Panama under a General Banking License granted by the National Banking Commission, today known as Superintendency of Banks, by means of Resolution 54-74 dated 15 February 1974;

Pursuant to Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, **MEGA INTERNATIONAL COMMERCIAL BANK CO., LTD.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to move its offices currently located on Calle 50 and Calle Margarita A. Vallarino to its new location on Avenida Balboa, Torre Davivienda, 9th floor, suite 9A-B, District and Province of Panama;

After the relevant analyses, the request submitted by **MEGA INTERNATIONAL COMMERCIAL BANK CO., LTD.** raises no objections;

According to Subparagraph 2, Paragraph 1 of Article 16 and Paragraph 2 of Article 58 of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for closing or moving banking establishments, and

RESOLVES:
