RESOLUTION SBP-0147-2020
(dated 24 November 2020)

THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS
in use of his legal powers, and

WHEREAS:

BANCO DE OCCIDENTE (PANAMÁ), S.A. is a bank established according to the laws of the Republic of Panama, authorized to engage in the banking business from Panama, under an International Banking License granted by means of Resolution 9-82 dated 16 March 1982 by the National Banking Commission, today known as Superintendency of Banks of Panama;

Pursuant to Article 58 (2) of the Banking Law, **BANCO DE OCCIDENTE (PANAMÁ), S.A.** has requested the Superintendency authorize it to temporarily move its headquarters currently located in the ground floor of Pan-American Life Bldg., on Calle Aquilino De La Guardia and Calle 50 to the Fourth Floor of the same building, as of 16 November 2020;

After the relevant analysis, the request submitted by **BANCO DE OCCIDENTE (PANAMÁ), S.A.** raises no objections; and

According to Article 16 (1)(2) and Article 58 (2) of the Banking Law, the Superintendent of Banks is the approving authority for moving banking establishments;

RESOLVES:

To authorize **BANCO DE OCCIDENTE (PANAMÁ), S.A.** to temporarily move its headquarters to the Fourth Floor of Pan-American Life Bldg., on Calle Aquilino De La Guardia and Calle 50, Panama City.

LEGAL GROUNDS: Article 16 (1)(2) and Article 58 (2) of the Banking Law.
